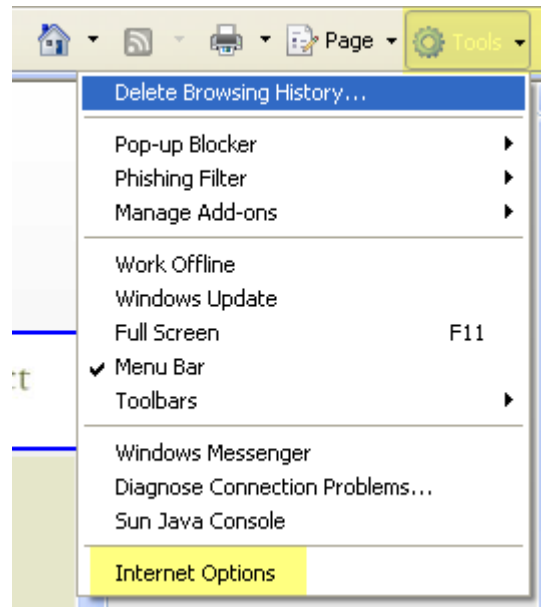


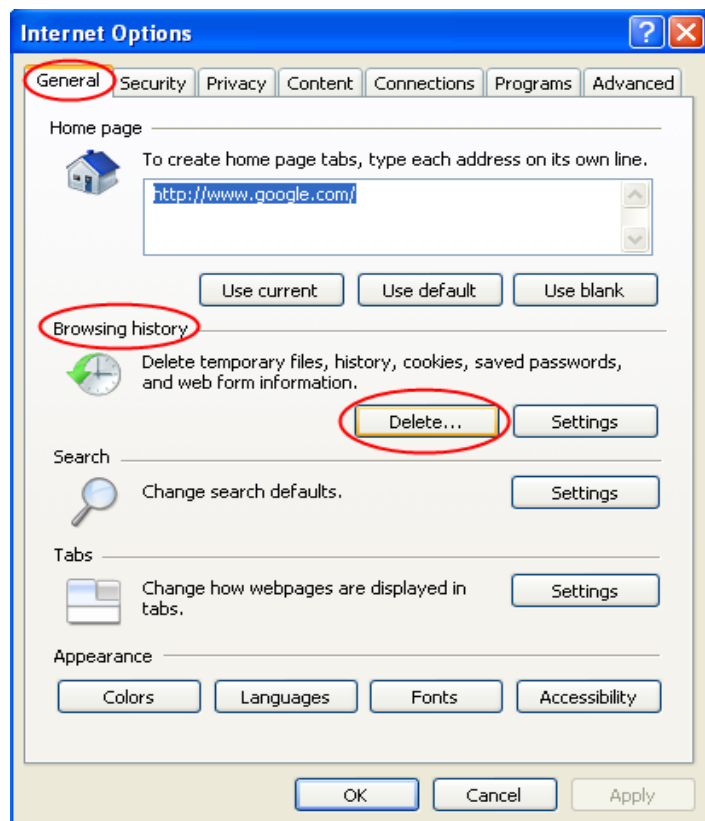
## Making Your Web Browser OPAS ONLINE Compatible

### For Internet Explorer

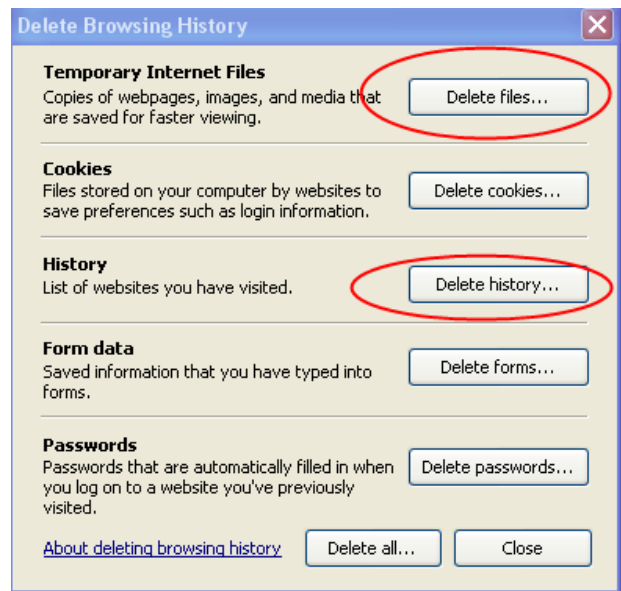
1. First clear the cache. Go to Tools>Internet Options:



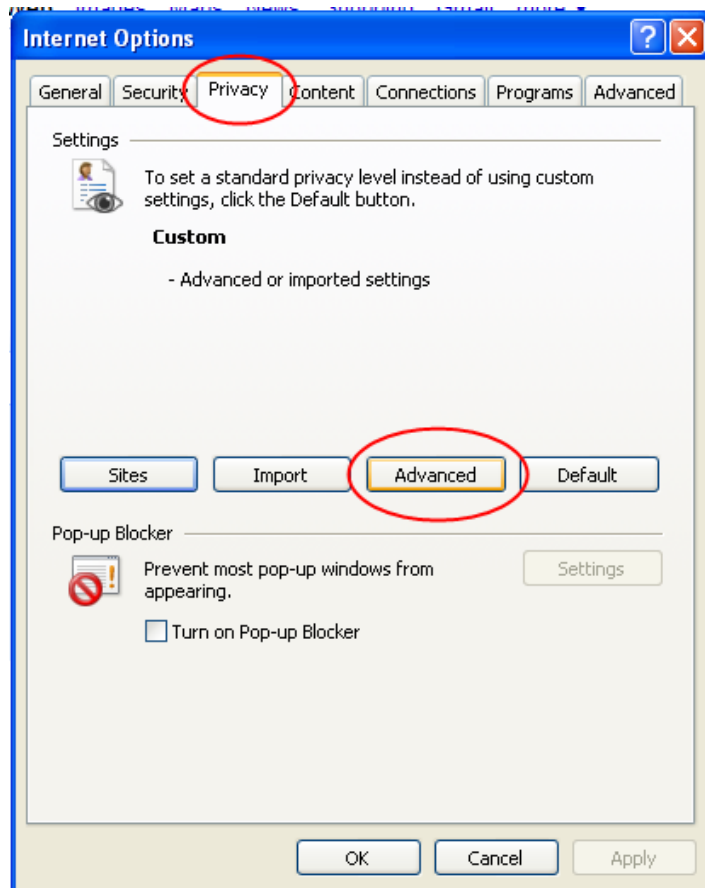
2. In the Internet Options dialog box, click the "General" tab. Go to "Browsing History" and click the "Delete" button:



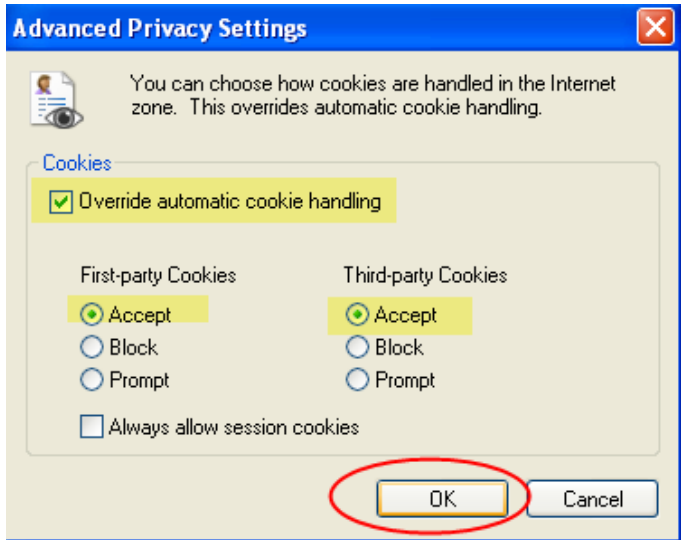
3. In the Delete Browsing History dialog box, delete the Temporary Internet Files and History by clicking these buttons:



4. Now allow 3<sup>rd</sup> party cookies. In the Internet Options dialog box, go to the "Privacy" tab and click "Advanced":

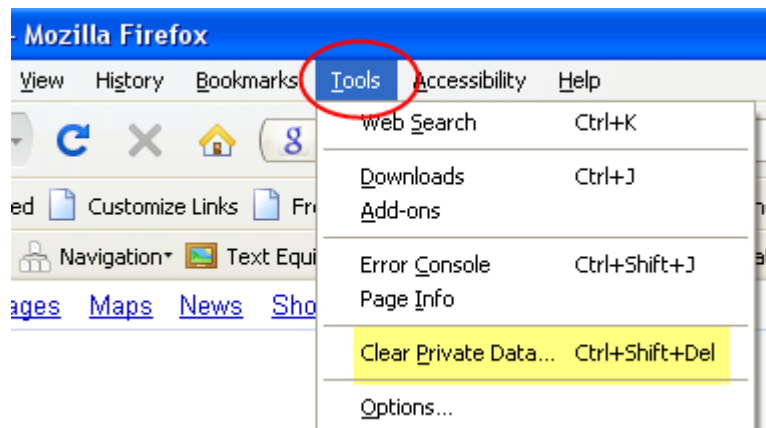


5. Check the box next to “Override automatic cookie handling” and choose to “Accept” first-party and “Accept” (or “Prompt”) third-party cookies. Then click “OK.” (Consult your IT department or contact OPAS Technical Support for more information on the difference between Accept and Prompt)

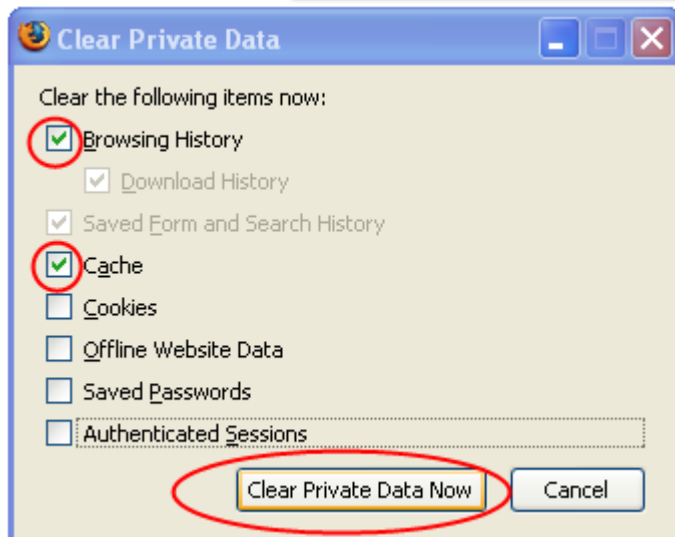


## In Firefox

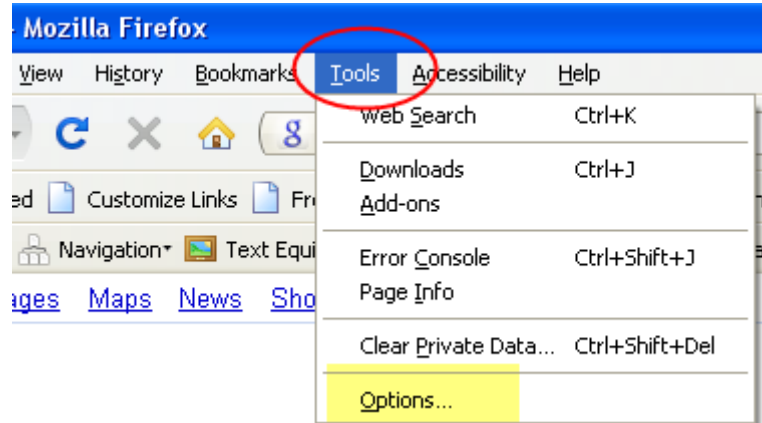
1. First clear the cache. Go to Tools> Clear Private Data



2. In the Clear Private Data dialog box, check the boxes for “Browsing History” and “Cache,” then click “Clear Private Data Now”



3. Now allow 3<sup>rd</sup> party cookies. Go to Tools> Options



4. In the Options dialog box, go to the "Privacy" tab. Make sure that the box next to "Accept third-party cookies" is checked. Then click "OK".
